STAMP OUT DIABETES

Stamp Out Diabetes is diabetes Specialist Nurse Led intervention session at Consett Medical Centre focusing on reducing the prevalence of type 2 diabetes in our local community.

The aim of this one-day education programme is to support people, identified as being at increased risk of diabetes, to reduce their risk of developing the disease by providing advice on diet, weight, and activity.

We are offering patients whose blood results fall into the pre diabetic range the opportunity to participate and therefore benefit from this programme.

Our DSNs Karl, Helen and Debbie, with help from our SPLW Abbie, are currently rolling this out to all patients who they feel can benefit from the programme.
